2. **Nomination Statement** (two to three pages), explaining why the nominee should be considered for an honorary degree from MSU.
3. **Supporting Letters** (at least two) from qualified recommenders who are familiar with the professional accomplishments and achievements of the nominee.
4. **Resume or Vita of nominee**
5. **Other supporting materials** as deemed necessary by the nominator.

Information should be complete so that the committee will be able to arrive at a decision based on the material submitted.

Incomplete nominations cannot be reviewed by the committee and will be returned to the Dean's office.



Care should be taken so that candidates are **not** aware of their nomination.
